

PROJECT OVERVIEW

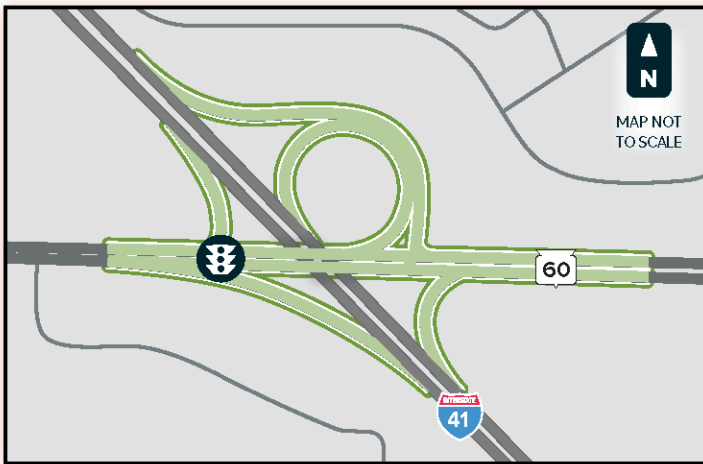
The Wisconsin Department of Transportation is scheduled to complete safety and pavement improvements to the I-41 interchange at WIS 60 in the village of Slinger, Washington County. Construction is scheduled to begin in mid-April and be completed in the fall of 2026.

The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project

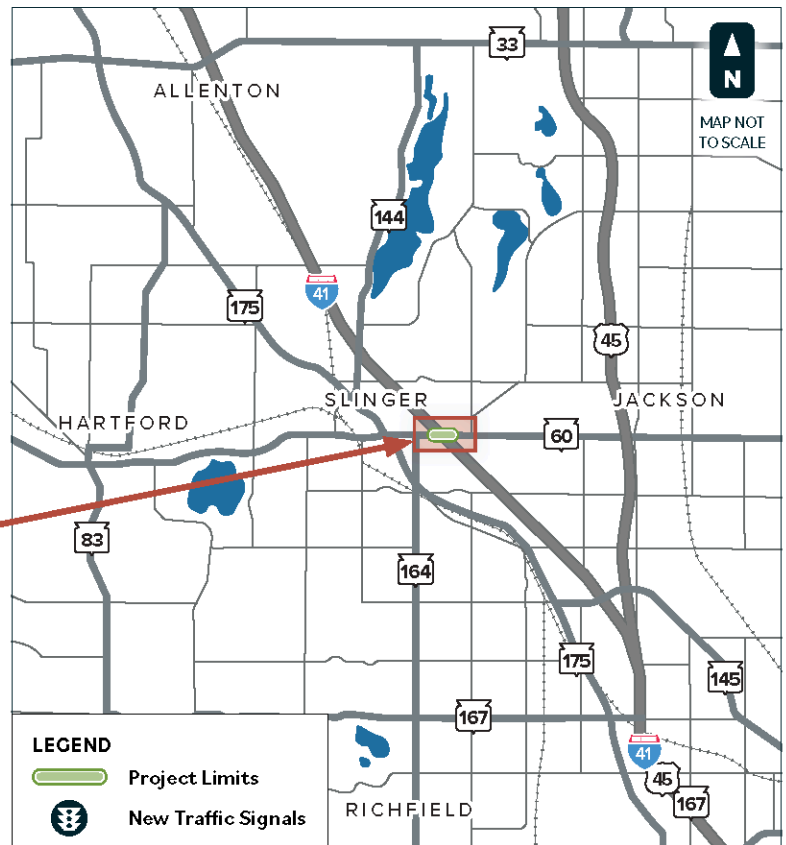
- Reconstruct the WIS 60 entrance ramp to I-41 southbound to address merging conflicts
- Widen and realign the right turn lane on the I-41 southbound exit ramp to WIS 60 to improve visibility
- Install traffic signals at the I-41 southbound exit ramp terminal
- Partial bridge deck removal and widening to increase the length of the left turn lanes on WIS 60 to I-41
- Other maintenance improvements, including pavement resurfacing, new pavement markings and signage

Traffic Impacts

- Long-term closures of the I-41 entrance and exit ramps at WIS 60
- Full closure of WIS 60 westbound over I-41 for approximately two weeks
- Long-term lane closures on WIS 60
- Occasional overnight closures of I-41 and WIS 60
- Detour routes will be posted during closures
